1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. BGM SOCIAL SERVICE CENTRE is a registered charitable trust, strives to uplift the weaker section in the society with special emphasis on the development basic needs of women and children. Organisation is also concentrating on the education of poor children's whom are unable to meet their educational expenses.
- 1.2. The registered office of the organization is situated at Neyyar Dam which is a well known tourist center which is laying close to sahayadri hills. Majority of the Peoples are farmers and Tribals whose main income is from agriculture. Though it is a well known tourist center developmental activities are comparatively in slow motion and number of poor families remains with out basic needs. The developmental activities implemented by the organization is so much appreciated by the peoples and local administrations.
- 1.3. This organization is managed by a managing committee consisting of seven members. Trust is mainly involved to develop basic human needs of needy poor rural people. In addition to it organization is involved in number of charitable activities, which is helping for the development of whole of the society. Organization had created number of employment opportunities in the rural areas through various training programmes and through project implementations. Some of the important activities under taken by the organization in the year 2003-04 are as follows.

2. SOCIAL WELFARE ACTIVITIES

Organisation is doing number of welfare activities for helping rural family members of the society.

2.1. Medical Aid

Organisation is providing medical aids to number of poor patients whom are approaching the members of the society. Medical aid is also given to members of the trust.

2.2. Marriage Help

Trust is providing number of aids in cash and in kind to the marriage purpose of poor young ladies. In certain cases it may meet the food expenses of the marriage party. Due to the custom of Dowry in marriage number of poor families are unable to meet marriage expenses of their daughters.

2.3. House Maintenance

Number of families with in the jurisdiction of the trust is living in small houses for which palm leaves are used for roof thatching. But some of them are unable to find money for roof thatching and living in bad situation during rainy seasons. Organization is providing funds to these poor peoples for roof thatching in addition to it fund are given for maintenance of houses which are damaged due to natural calamities.

2.4 Adult education Programmes

Trust is actively participating in adult education programmes. Organisation is providing classes to 120 adult members and classes are conducted at different areas of Neyyadam

2.5. Vermicompost Project

During the year organization established 60 nos of vermicompost units. The project is completed in two phases. Training given to number of farmers for making vericompost and its use are also Described to them at training classes.

2.6 Programme for Women Development and Empower through Self Help Groups.

During the year organization implemented the above project successfully with the support of grama panchyaath and rural women members. Twenty numbers of SHG were formed and training given to them for goat rearing and banana tissue cultur and bee keeping. After completing the training 13 nos of goat rearing units and 10 nos of bee keeping units were established. All these women units are now working efficiently by meeting the objectives of the project.

3. CHILD WELFARE & HOUSE SCHOOL PROGRAMME

At present trust is running 14 nos of study centers at various places of Poovachal, Kallikadu and Vellarada Grama Panchyaath. In each center at about 25 to 30 nos of poor students are trained under House School Programme. Students are studying between I to VIIth standards. Cultural programmes and sports competition etc are conducted at each center at different dates. Tuition are given to these children's at free of cost. Organization is also providing scholarships to selected students based on merits.

4. COMPUTER AWARENESS PROGRAMMES

Organisation is running a Computer Training Centre through which training are given to nos of students on Information Technology.

5. AYURVEDIC FREE CLINIC

Organisation is running an ayurvedic free clinic at Puruvimala, Neyyardam, which is situated with in the forest areas providing consultation and medicines on every Wednesdays. At about 40 to 70 aadivasies (Tribes) are visiting the clinic for consultation and medicines.

6. HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAMMES

Organisation is conducting health awareness programmes at various study centers which is run by the organization. During the year it conducted seminar on Child health and nutrition, Rural Sanitation and Hygiene. Classes were taken by NGO leaders, Doctors, Health Workers and members of the trust.

7. ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS PROGRAMME

During the year organization conducted programmes on Environment awareness. The objective of the programmes are to create awareness to the local people about the requirement of healthy environment for the existence of living organisms. Classes were taken by various eminent lectures and students.

8. DRINKING WATER PROJECT-WELL CONSTRUCTION

For avoiding drinking water deficiency and to put an end to the wandering of women's for water, organization constructed number of wells

at Kallikadu and at Poovachal Panchyaath. Number of poor families are approaching the trust for availing assistance for the construction of Wells.

9. LATRINE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

one of the objective of the organization is to provide basic human needs to the poor rural peoples. For the purpose it constructed number of Latrines at kallikadu and Poovachal panchayath. Number of poor families are approaching the trust for availing assistance for the construction of Latrines .

10. TRAINING PROGRAMMES

During the year organization conducted following training programmes

10.1 Tailoring Training

Orgnisation is running a tailoring unit which provides training to unemployed women beneficiaries. For the purpose it appointed a tailoring teacher. After completing the training organization making all assistance to these women beneficiaries for starting individual tailoring shops.

10.2 Straw Greeting Card Making

Training given to 25 women beneficiaries for making Straw greeting cards. Materials used for making such greeting cards are straw and paperpulp. Training classes were taken by Manava Mithram Suresh Kumar.

10.3 Soap Making

This training given to 30 women beneficiaries for making washing and toilet soaps. Trainees were given assistance for setting their own soap making units after training. Organisation is assisting them by providing technical know how and gives directions for marketing and fund raising.

10.4 Pickle Making

Organisation provided training to 45 women beneficiaries for making pickles and its packing. Raw materials are cheaply available from the local market. Organisation also providing marketing support.

10.5 Medicinal Plant Cultivation

Demand for medicinal plants are also high due to the increased trend of the people to follow ayurveda treatment. But availability of medicinal plants is less. So considering above factors organization is providing training to number of beneficiaries as a continuation program in medicinal plant cultivation.

10.6 International Volunteers Camp

We are arranging two International Volunteers Camp in Neyydam Area with the help of SCI and BGM Volunteers. One camp was Men and Women attended and other camp attended only women's from different countries.

11. APPROVAL OF ANNUAL ACCOUNTS

During the meeting Annual Accounts for the year was adopted and approved by the members of the organisation. See Annexure -1 for annual accounts.

12. PROPOSED ACTION PLANS FOR 2004-2005

At the meeting, organisation decided to improve its activities conducted than the activities of 2003 -2004.

13. EVALUATIONS AND CONCLUSION

BGM has done lot of charitable activities during the year 2003-04. Number of poor peoples are approaching us to provide a helping hand to them for education of childrens, house maintenance, marriage help, latrine /well construction ,medical aid etc. Organisation is providing help to the extent it can. But due to financial problems it can not satisfy the request

of majority of poor peoples. Organisation is now approaching number of agencies for assistance to implement rural charitable project which provide basic human needs and employment opportunities. We express our sincere thanks to all persons and agencies who helped us by providing support either cash or in kind. We can together work for the welfare of poor human beings to the extent we can with the great support of God's grace.
